

#### **New ALT Questions Checklist**

Here are a list of things it would be useful to discuss with your supervisor (and other colleagues) when you first start working at your school

#### Household and budget

- Who should I contact if I have questions about my apartment (e.g. in an emergency, or if an appliance breaks)?
- Are there any upcoming bills or taxes I should be aware of (e.g. inhabitants tax, ongoing key money payments)? When do I need to make these payments and how much are they?

#### School attendance

- Are there any upcoming school events that I should be aware of (e.g. public holidays, special school events on weekends, compensatory holiday)?
- Are there any days with events that I must attend, and am therefore unable to take nenkyuu (e.g. English camp, school opening ceremony)?
- What is the process for taking nenkyuu (annual leave)? Who should I consult? Do I need to submit a form?
- What happens if I am sick and cannot come to school, or need to visit the clinic? Who should I contact? Can I take byokyuu (sick leave) or should I take nenkyuu?

#### Around the office

- How do I find out if the schedule has changed (e.g. cancelled or moved lessons)?
- Do I need permission to do things around the office (e.g. use the photocopier/printer)?
- If I have free time, what am I able to do (e.g. study Japanese, TEFL course etc)?

#### **English department**

- Which teachers will I be working with, and what lessons do they teach?
- What were the duties of my predecessor?
- Is it ok if I do \_\_\_\_\_ (e.g. start an English board, join Judo club)?
- Does this school have English club? What should my role be?

#### For each individual teacher:

• What is my role in your class (e.g. planning and leading lessons, team teaching, assisting)? (If you are required to plan) How would you like to work together to plan lessons (e.g. when should planning meetings take place, when should plans be submitted)?
